loud singing over those who have found their delight and gladness in Him.



# The greatest need children have is to know and cherish the infinite value of God.

We want children to become so saturated with the Word of God that they treasure Him alone as the One who saves and satisfies the heart.

The goal of our curriculum is to fuel spiritual desire in children by exalting the greatness and worth of God and His glorious work through Jesus Christ.

We invite you to take part in a bold vision for children's ministry; a vision beyond the routine of recruiting volunteers and planning activities; a vision that recovers the biblical mission for children's ministry: exalting God as the source, means, and purpose of all things.

### Philosophy & Distinctives

#### **Our Mission**

Children Desiring God exists to equip the body of Christ to spread to the next generations a passion for the supremacy of God in all things for the joy of all peoples through Jesus Christ.

Our aim is to impart to children a vision of God, who He is, and who we are in relation to Him, and to establish them with a foundation of doctrine and truth. We want them biblically grounded, seeing God as the hero of every story, with a God-centered world view and a faith that will hold them when the days of testing come. We want them to love the Lord their God with all their heart, and to delight in Him forever.

### **God-centeredness**

We believe that the Bible is a book first and foremost about God. The other characters in the Bible merely point to God. In our curriculum, we have attempted to exalt the Triune God—to show Him as a great and almighty God. In every lesson, Scripture is studied in the context of the question, "What does this say about God?"

### **Depth**

We believe that children can handle deep truth at a young age. We want to fill them with solid biblical truth that will give them a sustaining foundation throughout life. For this reason, the curriculum continually refers children to the Word of God; Bibles are an essential tool for children studying CDG curricula. We believe the Bible must be taught in depth, yet in a child-friendly, interesting manner.

#### Incremental

We believe that children learn "precept upon precept." Truth presented on a simple level in the preschool years is reinforced and expanded at primary levels. For this reason, truths are reintroduced to the children as they grow older, each time digging deeper and widening the scope of their understanding.

#### **Application**

We believe that faith comes through hearing the Word of God (Romans 10:17). However, teaching falls short if it simply feeds words into children's minds. We want truth to be clearly understood. Therefore, God's truth is explained through illustration, connecting the known to the unknown. Because interaction with God's truth is critical, children are encouraged to look up Scripture passages, discover and respond to truth.

### Theology

Titles offered by CDG were first developed for use at Bethlehem Baptist Church in Minneapolis. The curriculum reflects reformed theology emphasizing an all-powerful, all-loving, sovereign Triune God directing everything to serve His glory and His good purpose. These curricula have been successfully used in evangelical churches of many denominations throughout North America and internationally.

### **Partnership with Parents**

We believe that before God, parents, not churches, have the primary responsibility for the spiritual nurture of their children. We have structured the curricula in a way that allows the church to "walk alongside" parents, enabling and equipping them in this God-given role. We strongly encourage parental involvement in the classroom and have developed meaningful Parent Resource Pages to encourage and enable parents to interact with their children over Scripture and the lesson content.

### **Stewardship of Resources**

The resources we offer have been specifically designed for durability and re-use. Teacher's materials and visual aids are printed and packaged for years of use.

### **Long-Term Perspective**

Our goal is that lesson truths and faith lessons will be remembered for many years. We provide both Parent Resource Pages and workbooks. Our student workbooks provide children with a review tool and parents with a tool for discussion and review at home.




### Preschool Curricula






### Sunday School Curricula

In Abiding in Jesus, author Sally Michael challenges youth to consider the daily impact of the cross in their lives as they turn from sin in repentance and place their faith in Jesus' work on the cross consistently in their everyday lives. Abiding in Jesus encourages youth to seek the grace of God to forsake sin, forgive others, commit all things to Jesus, and to live in daily dependence upon Jesus. Inspired by Jesus' words in John 15, this curriculum will teach students to remain connected to the true vine, Jesus Christ, during various daily situations in order to bear fruit in their spiritual lives and to have true fellowship with other believers. The material features an interactive teaching approach that combines teaching and small group discussion, as well as application and prayer time. A unique aspect of this curriculum is the fellowship opportunity for students at the end of each lesson.

These resources will have the same features and components as their English counterparts, but the text will be entirely in Spanish.

Translating curriculum is a complex process. There are many components (e.g., lessons, student workbooks, visuals, parent resource pages, etc.), and because these materials are intended for instruction, the process involves not only the translation of text, but also the contextualization of illustrations. What works in one church or culture contextually may not work in another without significant revision. Trumping this complexity, however, is our resolve to stay God-centered, theologically true to the original work, and faithful to our philosophies and distinctives.

We thank the Lord for raising up a people with a passion to help us fulfill our mission—to equip the body of Christ to spread to the next generations a passion for the supremacy of God in all things for the joy of <u>all</u> peoples through Jesus Christ.

### Plan for the Years Ahead


